Rules of the Competition

- 1. Applications are invited from print and on-line journalists working in the countries of Austria, Albania, Bulgaria, Croatia, Germany, Hungary, Macedonia, Romania and Serbia.
- 2. Each entrant may enter only once but may submit one or more reports on the same subject.
- 3. All entries including texts published or other forms of journalistic action must have occurred between May 1, 2009 and May 31, 2010.
- 4. The deadline for entries is June 15, 2010.
- 5. The Prize winners will receive a *Courage in Journalism Award* Certificate and a financial amount of 10,000 €.
- 6. The WAZ Media Group and IFJ reserve the right to utilise all material submitted for presentation and media use and to reproduce it for the purposes of promoting the *Courage in Journalism Award* and for allowing a telecast of the awards presentation ceremony.
- 7. All entrants are required to establish their *bona fides* as media professional and journalist and must certify that the entry covers original work, apart from normal sub-editorial/production treatment.
- 8. All entries should declare any subsequent formal corrections, challenges to the accuracy of an entry or claims of plagiarism or defamation against the work
- 9. Entrants should keep copies of all material submitted, as entries will not be returned.
- 10. Where the entry is a collaborative effort, all major contributors should be included including producers, researchers, journalists and editors, at the time the entry is lodged. A team entry may comprise a maximum of five individuals.

Judging

11. An independent jury made up of respected media professionals and experts will examine the entries and choose the winners.

12. The decision of the jury is final. The jury has the right to reject an entry, which, in their opinion, does not comply with the requirements of the competition. The *Courage in Journalism Award* sponsors reserve the right to withdraw a Prize if it is later found the entrant did not comply with the entry conditions.

Judging Criteria

- 13. The Prize is awarded to editors, reporters or media staff whose actions, in the investigation, preparation or dissemination of journalistic work exposing corruption or abuse of power, demonstrate exemplary courage and professionalism in the face of intimidation or undue pressure.
- 14. The jury will consider the entries in relation to the objectives of promoting understanding and debate on the issue of democratic development and defence of ethical and quality journalism.
- 15. The jury will consider general criteria including:
 - > Relevance, newsworthiness and impact of the information
 - > Research required to gather information and resources available and effort expended in the preparation of the work
 - Quality of writing, originality, presentation and respect for ethical principles
