1. How is the SOS help-line for Roma women, opened 6 years ago in Nis, contributing to their protection from domestic violence and emancipation?
2. The association of businesswomen “Eve” from Valjevo helps female citizens to develop or start their own businesses, together with other members from Sabac, Loznica and the entire Kolubara and Macva district
